1) General

- It was agreed to avail of a new offer of photographs for 1st and 6th class, with one free photo of each child supplied and the option to purchase more.
- A series of music workshops has been approved for 2012/13. These workshops are designed to equip teachers to continue musical work with their students in the future.

2) Correspondence

- The Board received a letter of resignation from teacher Naomi Gough, we are very sorry to see her go and wish her all the best in her future endeavours.

3) Policy

- Final changes to the Healthy Eating Policy have been agreed and the revised policy will be ratified at or before the next meeting.
- The Code of Behaviour is currently being reviewed by staff; a draft will then be prepared by the Board and circulated to the Parents' Association Committee and Student Council for their input before being finalised.
- A number of minor changes to the Admissions Policy were agreed at the request of the School Inspector.

4) New Building

- Unfortunately, the Department of Education and Skills (DES) has refused our application for prefabs for 2012/2013. This will put us under significant pressure in terms of space for the coming year, until such time as our new building is in place. The Board is working hard to ensure we find the best possible solutions with the resources available to us.
