- Children may apply to join Greystones Educate Together National School at any time in the school year.
- Places are allocated on a first come first served principle. Once a place becomes available it will be offered to the next child on our waiting list, in order of date of pre-enrolment. If a place is not accepted and taken up at the time of offering it will be offered to the next person on the waiting list.
- Places cannot be held for children until the next school year.
- Apart from the Special Class, non-Junior Infants cannot defer a place which has been offered to them. However, if the parents/guardians want to put them on the list for the next year or a different class they will be issued with a new pre-enrolment number and put on the non-Junior Infant List for that year/class.
